Summer Camp Age 9-14 Tier A: \$530 B: \$490 C: \$450

New friends and challenging activities go hand-in-hand during this exciting week of camp. Every camper spends time horseback riding, making crafts, shooting archery, visiting the lake, swimming in the pool, and climbing the tower. Activities change as campers age through three unique programs: Explorers, Pathfinders and Navigators. Campers choose Clubs and Clinics to personalize their camp experience after they arrive at camp.

Theme Clubs (\$30 extra):

- Target Sports: Shoot archery, crossbows, pellet guns, and .22s at Platte River State Park. Takes place of all campers clubs.
- Silver Spurs: 3 extra hours of horseback riding, taking the place of one club activity.



Ranch Camps Age 10-17 Tier A: \$630 B: \$590 C: \$550

Ranch Camp Age 10-17 Advanced Ranch Age 11-17* Challenge Ranch Age 14-17*

The Ranch Camp experience focuses on time with a new horse companion. Each camper is assigned a horse for the week and spends half of each day in lessons on riding technique. Each session is led by our trained Kitaki wranglers. During the other half of the day, campers in Ranch Camp experience the other traditional activities at Kitaki.

Ranch Camp Achievement Levels: To optimize safety and provide a progressive, productive learning environment, riders are evaluated and grouped by skill level. *Camp Kitaki employs a progressive system of skill verification in our horsemanship camps. For safety reasons, campers are asked to prove their skills before enrolling in higher levels of Ranch Camp.



Discoverers Camp Age 7-8 Tier A: \$530 B: \$490 C: \$450

Our youngest campers' experience is designed to introduce them to all aspects of camp in a comfortable way. Higher staff-to-camper ratios and unique activities including a special Discoverers hideout, horseback riding, imaginative play at Fort Pawnee, and a unique Discoverers campfire pizza cookout make for one unforgettable week! Discoverer campers live close to the dining hall and pool for easy access to fun.



Ranger Camp Age 11-13 Tier A: \$530 B: \$490 C: \$450

Ranger camp is the most unique experience we have to offer at Kitaki. Kids in Ranger Camp will function as their own community, working together on food preparation, outdoor skills, and living in a small community. Combining that with unique experiences such as the Marionette Climb on our Tango Tower, the Water Hole Wallow, and an overnight canoe trip make this one unforgettable experience!



Trailblazers Camp Age 13-15 Tier A: \$530 B: \$490 C: \$450

Combining activities designed for older campers with traditional Kitaki favorites, Trailblazer Camp is the best of all worlds for ages 13 to 15. Clubs are replaced with adventures at our challenge course, and Trailblazer campers participate in the Trailblazer Decathlon Challenge. Campers also plan and execute a overnight campout in a special location. This one-week experience builds self-confidence and character with new and stimulating challenges.



Adventure Mini Camp Age 7-9 Tier A: \$345 B: \$320 C: \$295

(1/2 Week Camp) Mini Camp is the perfect way to "try us out" or fit Camp Kitaki into your busy summer! This half-week program features structured, age-appropriate activities that introduce the great traditions Camp Kitaki has to offer. Highlights include swimming, a campfire, crafts, and archery. However, Mini Campers do not experience all the same activities, such as horseback riding, as a camper staying the full week.
